Getting ready for our new Year 7 students!

First Day and Timings

All Year 7 students start on **Tuesday 2nd September 2025 at 8.40am**. All Year 7 students should enter the school at the main gate on Kilburn Park Road. Students will need to be in full school uniform and have their school bag and equipment with them. If you are dropping your child(ren) to school via car, please do take care where you drop your child off and/or where you park. The area can get very busy as the term starts, so please be careful and do not park on any of the yellow lines. Year 7 students will finish on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday at 3.30pm and 2:40pm on Friday.

Medication

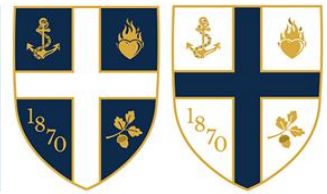
If your child(ren) takes regular medication or will need a health care plan, please pop into school during the first week to discuss this with our medical team. If your child is diabetic, asthmatic, has regular medication and/or has an EpiPen pen, please can you ensure your child have their medication with them on day one and speak to our medical team to ensure any medical/toilet passes can be sorted as soon as possible. We can store securely spare inhalers, EpiPens and any other medication once provided by the parent/carer.
