What is GCSE Math About?

- GCSE Math starts from Year 7
- In Years 10 and 11 we officially start the Higher and Foundation Schemes of work (Specification)
- We have 6 Higher Math Classes and 2 Foundation Math Classes in Year 10 and 11.
- Students are placed in Higher or Foundation Tier based on their performance in Years 7 - 9 Maths.

- Measurement
 - Statistics

What is GCSE Math Tiers?

- Higher Tier (Grades 3 – 9)
- Foundation Tier (Grades 1 – 5)
 - Passing grades (4 – 9)
- To do A-Level Math (POST Year 11) you **MUST** achieve a Grade 7 or above in GCSE Math.
