and collaboration – skills valued everywhere.






WHAT IS EDUQAS GCSE MUSIC?

- Performing – 30%
- Composing – 30%
- Listening & Appraising Exam – 40%



PERFORMING (30 %)

Performing

- One **solo** performance
- One **ensemble** performance
- Minimum total duration: **4 minutes**
- You can perform on *any* instrument — voice included
- Backing tracks allowed



COMPOSING (30 %)

Composing (30%)

- You compose **two** pieces
- One free choice
- One set by Eduqas
- Use school software- BandLab
- Develop your creativity and style



LISTENING AND APPRaising (30 %)

Listening & Appraising (40%)

- 1 hr 15 min written exam
- Music from:
 - Musical Forms & Devices
 - Music for Ensemble
 - Film Music
 - Popular Music
- Identify instruments, techniques, genres, and feature





- Workshops & guest musicians
- School concerts and showcases
- Bands, choirs, ensembles
- Recording studio time
- Instrumental lessons available
