Course structure and Assessment:



► Qualification in Personal Development and Employability Skills

- This is a 2-year course (Year 10 and 11) / 3 lessons a week

Assessment:

- There are no exams for qualifications. Assessment is by means of a **Portfolio** which is **internally** and **externally** verified.

The Portfolio:

- A collection of evidence by students which meets the requirement of the assessment criteria.

Skills and Competencies:

- Communication, teamwork, leadership, presentation, organisation, enterprise and career planning

Awards

- Qualification size: 2 units
